# 2022-2023 REGISTRATION

Hockey West Island is open to residents of Pointe-Claire and Dorval.

# TO REGISTER:

For the 2022-23 Hockey season ALL registrations must be done online using the Hockey Canada Registry.

(New Members will need to create a Hockey Canada Account. For information or help, consult the <u>Online guide for HCR</u>).

## PAYMENTS:

Payments are made through the Hockey Canada portal using a credit card.

# FAMILY DISCOUNT:

A \$100 discount will be applied to the third and any additional children of the same family. Proof of residency is required, including both parents' driver's permits and report cards of ALL players showing the same home address. No discounts for Regional Program Fees.

## Details:

- 1. All Preseason Warm-up Camp fees are *non-refundable*. Session dates and schedules will be posted on the HWI website under "Schedules".
- 2. **Regional Programs** consist of: Atom AA & BB; Peewee AA, BB; Bantam AA, BB; Midget AA, BB; Junior A, B; Senior. The Regional program fee must be paid on a separate cheque and post-dated September 30, 2022. The cheque will ONLY be cashed when the player makes the team. Regional Fees are in addition to the Basic Registration. Note that Junior and Senior Regional fees are already incorporated into the registration fee.
- 3. **NSF Fees:** An additional \$40 charge for all NSFs.
- 4. **Email Policies:** By providing your email address, you are giving HWI permission to contact you regarding all affairs relevant to HWI.
- 5. Refund Policies: Refund requests *MUST BE MADE IN WRITING* on the Refund Form available on our website to the Registrar *ONLY*, and are subject to a \$25 administration fee. If written notice is received before the start of the first regular-season league game, then 15% of the basic registration is retained. Thereafter, 50% of the registration fee is retained. No refunds will be issued for requests submitted after November 1, 2022, except for Pre-Novice, where December 1, 2022 is the deadline. <u>REFUND PAYMENTS WILL BE PROCESSED ON AN INDIVIDUAL BASIS</u>. Please note, for double letter players that leave tryouts without being released (quit), Hockey West Island reserves the right to charge \$15 per tryout session and/or exhibition game attended. This charge does not apply to players released from a double letter team.

- 6. **Medical Refunds.** If a refund is requested due to medical reasons, a player is entitled to a refund of 25% of the registration fees until January 15, 2022. A doctor's letter, including the Refund Form, is required within 7 calendar days of the incident. The player would then be considered "inactive" and will be removed from the registration list by the Registrar. This status means that the player CANNOT play or practice. Playing an inactive member will result in the forfeiture of any and all games. Inactive player(s) participating will not be covered by any insurance, as they are not duly registered.
- 7. **Team Budgets:** Teams often require additional funds for tournaments and extra ice time. Parents must approve budgets for any amount over \$150 (\$200 for Regional Teams).
- 8. Players will be registered only when all forms are complete and correct. No player can go on the ice or practice with a team until their registration is received (with payment) by the HWI Registrar.
- 9. Hockey West Island reserves the right to limit the number of registrations per category and therefore waiting lists may be necessary.
- 10. **Code of ethics:** All parents and players must sign a code of ethics as required by Hockey Quebec regulations.
- 11. HWI provides regular season jerseys and game socks only, all other equipment is the player's responsibility. All required equipment must be worn on the ice. Please visit <u>hockeywestisland.org/registration/equipment-list</u> for a list of needed equipment.
