

HOW TO REGISTER FOR HOCKEY SUR MEASURE

****THIS PROGRAM IS ONLY OPEN TO PLAYERS WHO RESIDE IN THE TERRITORY COVERED BY HOCKEY WEST ISLAND, WHICH IS DORVAL AND POINTE-CLAIRE. NO EXCEPTIONS CAN BE MADE.**

WHAT YOU WILL NEED TO REGISTER:

To be eligible to register with Hockey West Island, **2 (TWO!) proofs of residence** (for either Dorval or Pointe-Claire) of the parent/guardian of a minor child **AND 1 (one) proof of age** of the Minor player must be uploaded into the player's account in Hockey Canada.

1. The accepted proofs of residence of the parent/guardian are a copy of any two documents from the list below:

- a home telephone account (such as Bell),
- a home internet account (such as Videotron),
- a Hydro Québec invoice,
- a municipal tax account (taxes, water tax, school tax),
- a Government of Quebec document (Income Tax, proof of change of address),
- official confirmation of the minor child's registration at school.

Any of the above must clearly show the parent/guardian's name and home address and may not be older than 6 months.

A rental lease (bail), driver's licence, or a Multi-card or citizen's card are not accepted by Hockey Canada as proof of residency. If you upload any of these, it will delay the registration.



2. The accepted proof of age is a copy of one document from the list below, clearly showing the child's age:

- birth certificate,
- Medicare card,
- Passport,
- Immigration papers.

Step 1: Go to the following link to register. [REGISTER](#)

Step 2: Click on "Register now" and then select "Create a new participant". (If your child participated in a hockey program within Hockey Canada in the past, they should *already* have a profile and Hockey Canada number.)

Step 3: Create your child's profile and register. Upload TWO proofs of residence, and one proof of age when asked.

If a registered player is determined to reside outside the Hockey West Island boundaries of Pointe-Claire and Dorval, the parent will be notified and the registration cancelled/refunded.
