2026–2027 Registration Information

Hockey West Island is again pleased to offer Senior hockey for the 2026–2027 season to eligible players from Pointe-Claire and Dorval.

Registration

- Registration will open at **noon on Saturday, June 20, 2026**.
- Only players who reside in the HWI territory of **Pointe-Claire or Dorval** are eligible to register. Players may be requested by Hockey Canada to upload two proofs of residence during the registration process. Please see the list of accepted proofs in our registration document. The address must clearly state the *adult player's address and must be dated 2026*.
- Exceptions may be considered for out-of-territory goaltenders only to ensure sufficient goalies for team formation.
- Due to this year's tryouts, registration does not guarantee a spot on a team.

Important Deadline

All players must be registered by **August 20, 2026**.

Players who are not registered by this date will not be eligible to participate in the evaluation process and will not be accepted afterward, *regardless of previous participation or playing experience*.

Team Formation

For the 2026–2027 season, Hockey West Island plans to form a maximum of **two Senior teams**. Each team is expected to consist of: 15–16 skaters, and 1–2 goaltenders

Mandatory Tryout Scrimmages

To ensure the creation of *competitive teams*, Hockey West Island will hold two mandatory tryout scrimmages during the third week of August.

- Tryouts will be conducted by professional independent evaluators.
- Players are expected to attend both sessions. Players who miss both sessions will be released.

Teams will be formed through a player draft in September following the evaluation process.

Player Releases

If registration numbers exceed available roster spots:

- Players not selected will be released before August 31.
- Released players will receive a full refund of their registration fees.
- Released players may then register with another association if they wish.

Why the Change?

After reviewing the Senior program and receiving feedback, Hockey West Island has decided to focus on:

- Building more competitive Senior teams
- Ensuring appropriate allocation of association resources
- Continuing to prioritize the development of youth hockey programs
